### **Purpose of the Challenge:**

To celebrate and recognize students for excellence in their mastery of hairdressing skills, and to create an interactive and engaging environment for competitors, spectators, and hairdressing industry professionals.

### **Competition Details:**

Due to logistical reasons, and difficulty in getting kits, students will supply their own equipment and products for cutting, colouring and styling. Mannequins and stations will be provided. To ensure consistency all students will compete on the same (provided) mannequins for both the up-do and formal cut and colour. The cut will be “long layers”, the colour details must be provided to Griselda ([gtreminio@sd62.bc.ca](mailto:gtreminio@sd62.bc.ca)) no later than Feb 15<sup>th</sup> for confirmation. Mannequins will initially be brunette with 14”-18” starting length.

### **\*\*\*REVIEW ALL RULES.**

- Cell phones must not be used during the competition. This includes texting and taking pictures.
- Drapery, clothing, jewellery and makeup may NOT be used on the mannequins. As is consistent with the Nationals.
- Hair for the up-do competition may not be cut or coloured.
- Students may not bring their own mannequins, the mannequins provided by Belmont for the competition are only accepted for judging.
- For the second competition, Salon cut and colour, the cut will be “long layers”, the starting length will be between 14”-18” depending on what the dealer can provide (we will know soon), and your colour details must be provided to Griselda [gtreminio@sd62.bc.ca](mailto:gtreminio@sd62.bc.ca) no later than Feb 15<sup>th</sup>.
- No written test will be administered.

This competition will allow the young stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following tests:

**Test #1 Formal up-do (no cut or colouring allowed)**

**Test #2 Salon Long Layers Cut (with colour enhancement)**

**Safety Instructions:** Competitors must demonstrate aptitude in safety awareness. First aid kits will be available on site.

**Equipment, Tools, & Materials Supplied by Host**

2 female Mannequins

Work station

**The competitor will provide all other equipment and supplies deemed necessary by the competitor, including but not limited to:**

- **Table top clamp style mannequin stand** for display during judging.
- **Shampoos/conditioners/towels** as required.
- **Styling tools and equipment**
- **Colouring chemicals, tools and equipment**
- **Hair weft, bobby/hair pins/elastics** - the use of T-pins is forbidden.

**Drapery, clothing, jewellery and makeup may NOT be used on the mannequins.**

### **Competitor Clothing Requirements:**

- Clothing should be clean and comfortable as would be worn by staff working in a modern hair salon.
- The competitor must wear the apron provided.
- Closed toed shoes are mandatory.

### **Competition Preparation:**

- ***Mannequin orders must be made by Feb 15th in order to guarantee delivery, we will reply once we have confirmation of hair length, it will be between 14-18" to start.***
- Contact Griselda ([gtreminio@sd62.bc.ca](mailto:gtreminio@sd62.bc.ca)) upon registration in order to confirm the products you wish to use for the colour. We just want to ensure fairness amongst competitors. You may use what you have been trained on, please just confirm with Griselda.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to source and purchase human hair wefts. Colour is the competitor's choice, but all weft colouring must be completed before competition day. Any number of wefts can be used, so long as the final product doesn't display more than 50% weft. All wefts can be held in place with pins only (no clips).

### **Judging/Distribution of Marks:**

- Prior to judging, all equipment and personal items must be removed from the competition floor.
- For judging, all mannequins must be placed upright and square to the mirror on a clamp style mannequin stand that is screwed securely to the table. Mannequin stand extenders or tripod stands are not permitted for mannequin display during judging.
- The judges must be able to clearly see the front of the mannequin in the mirror while viewing the back.
- All scores assigned are final. As is the BC Skills practice, scores other than 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will not be posted.

### **Where applicable, assessment will be based upon:**

1. Structural Form
  - Shape and balance
  - Hair to face relationship.
  - Manner in which hair surrounds face.
2. Workmanship
  - Use of colour
  - Shading
  - Details and dimensions
  - Neatness and quality
3. Originality in Design
  - Harmony of textures and colours
  - Has the design been seen before?
  - Is there a new/different concept used?
4. Creativity
  - Originality of creativity.

**IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMPETITOR FAMILIARIZES HER/HIMSELF WITH THE ASSESSMENT CHECKLISTS, AND ON EACH TEST DESCRIPTION. DEMERITS WILL RESULT IN THE CASE OF INFRACTIONS OF RULES AND/OR TEST GUIDELINES.**

<b>General Assessment checklist:</b>	
Equipment and personal items are not left on competition floor during judging.	
Mannequin is placed upright and square to the mirror for judging.	
A clamp-style mannequin stand is used, no extenders/tripods are used for mannequin display.	
Drapery, clothing, jewelry and/or makeup is not used on mannequin(s).	
Coloured spray, gel, mousse or colour markers have not been used.	
Stop time has been respected.	
No coaching /communication with or from audience/competitor.	
Cell phones are not to be used on the competition floor for any reason.	
No use of technical support such as formulas, pictures, drawings, notes etc.	
Mannequin model/type provided has been used.	
All labels, containers and applicators of styling and colour products must be covered. Electrical equipment combs and brushes exempt.	
Tools/equipment are not borrowed from another competitor.	
Only one plug is used at any one time.	

## TEST #1 – Formal Up-Do

**Time limit: 2 hours (9-11am)**

The competitors create a commercial/traditional up-do (no half-down) on long hair.

A mannequin will be loaned for this test, and are new. The mannequin hair must not be cut or coloured in any way. The competitors will be asked to remove the mannequin from the bag and brush the hair straight back. All materials that the competitor uses for this test must be displayed on their workstation at the beginning of the test. The judges will inspect competitor workstations.

### Details:

1. A formal up-do is of the competitors choosing; however, judges will be looking for a traditional, elegant formal up-do. The goal is to produce a style that may be worn at a wedding or special, grand event.
2. The competitor may not cut or colour the mannequin's hair. Products containing colours and glitter are forbidden.
3. Styling Products: please place aside during judging, and provide your own styling products.
4. Styling Tools: All styling tools are allowed and are to be brought to the competition by the competitor. If there is a special tool you may want, or if there is a tool that you do not have, please email Griselda [gtreminio@sd62.bc.ca](mailto:gtreminio@sd62.bc.ca) ahead of time to see if one can be available on loan.
5. The use of supports and/or padding of any kind are forbidden.
6. Hair additions (weft) are optional:
  - a. The hair addition must be laid out on the table prior to start time in the form of one weft that has not been pre-set or straightened in any way – all finishing work is to be performed during the test.
  - b. Wefts must be supplied by the competitor and are not to exceed maximum 30 cm (12") hair length, and 50cm (20") weft width. The full weft must be presented flat on the table as one piece at the start of tests.
  - c. The weft must not cover more than 50% of the design, and must not be applied all in one place to form a hairpiece or ponytail.
  - d. Wefts must not be attached with T-pins.
7. During judging, the judges must be able to see the complete hairstyle, including the top. Mannequins must be presented on a table stand without an extender, facing square to the mirror. No props, makeup or jewellery are allowed.
8. Competitors who do not observe the instructions above will be de-merited by the Sages.
9. Only 1 plug per competitor is available on the competition floor, and only 1 device can be used at a time on this plug (no multiple adapters).

TEST #1 – checklist:	
All materials used are displayed prior to test start.	
A weft is optional.	
The weft is displayed (as one piece for weft) prior to test start.	
The weft has not been pre-set or straightened.	
The weft and/or ornament cover less than 50% of the design.	
The weft has not been applied in one place to form a hairpiece or ponytail.	
The weft has not been fastened with the use of T-pins.	

## TEST # 2 Salon Long Layers Cut (with colour enhancement)

Time limit: 3 hours

The Competitor will create a salon long layers cut and style with colour enhancement that is consistent with commercial cut and colour.

### Colour:

- Mannequin may not be pre-lightened/bleached prior to competition.
- A minimum of 2 colours must be used and all hair must be coloured during the competition.
- During the competition all colouring techniques are allowed.
- The choice of colour is free and must be provided by competitor.
- No colour sprays, gels, mousses or other temporary colouring products are allowed.
- Competitors must be mindful of staining. No covering of face during colour application is allowed, but barrier cream may be used around the hairline.

### Haircut:

- Mannequin's hair MUST be kept long.
- The mannequin will come with 14-18" length hair and should remain long after cut.
- No pre-cutting is permitted (altered in length and/or density).
- All haircutting tools may be used except clippers or trimmers.
- Cut should be 90 degree elevation and 180 degree elevation.

### Styling:

- Competitors must style the hair with a blow dryer and brush/comb only. No irons of any kind may be used during test #2.
- No products containing glitter are allowed.
- Wigs, hairpieces, bobby pins, clips, and elastics are forbidden.

**Set-up of mannequin will be performed within the 3-hour allotment for test #2. No embellishment of mannequin (makeup, jewellery or draping) is permitted for test #2.**

<b>TEST #2 – Long layer cut (WITH COLOUR ENHANCEMENT)</b>	
assessment checklist:	
The mannequin has not been pre-coloured.	
A minimum of 2 colours is evident in the finished look.	
Temporary colour has not been used.	
All hair has been coloured during test #2.	
The mannequin skin is not stained.	
The mannequin has not been pre-cut or otherwise altered in length and/or density.	
Clippers and/or trimmers have not been used.	
Irons have not been used in the styling.	
Wigs, hairpieces, bobby/hair pins or elastics have not been used.
