\$500.00 bursary awarded to one Graduating Student from one of the three area high schools: Bulkley Valley Christian, Ebenezer Reformed or Smithers Secondary School.

Qualifications

Grade 12 Student, graduating in 2026

Must reside in Quick or other rural Smithers area.

Upon graduation will be attending university, college or trade school program.

Applicants must submit a handwritten or typed letter including:

- Place of residence
- Future Education plans
- Volunteer &/or community related activities
- Work experience
- Rural activity interests

Selection

Preference will be given to students who are taking courses related to agriculture or other rural interests.

Bursary funds will be issued upon selected student providing official proof of enrollment at a post-secondary institution, university, college or trade school.

Proof of enrollment must be provided within two (2) calendar years of high school graduation. If proof is not received within this time, bursary will be revoked.

ALL decisions of the selection committee will be considered **final**.
